Closure of the accreditation procedure of the Doctoral School of Innovation Management of Óbuda University

As a result of the accreditation examination, the Board of the Hungarian Accreditation Committee supports the application for the establishment of the Doctoral School of Innovation Management (D253) of Óbuda University, with the following core member composition:

The accreditation of the doctoral school is valid until 24 February 2028, and the accreditation report is based on I.2. Areas to be developed, the doctoral school will send an action plan to the HAC by 24 February 2024.

Justification

Based on the self-assessment prepared by the Doctoral School of Innovation Management (D253) to be established at Óbuda University, the reviewed public university documents and online interviews, the HAC Visiting Committee concludes that the quality assurance system of the Doctoral School of Innovation Management (hereinafter referred to as the MSc) is uniformly structured in accordance with the principles of ESG (Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area). it covers the whole DI.

With regard to the nature of the procedure (establishment), the following processes can only be assessed at the plan level: the quality assurance and development processes of the DI are planned; its planning, control, measurement and evaluation procedures are regular. The relationship between management processes and quality assurance processes can be demonstrated, the management of education and research is partially adequate, and its direction is in line with the strategy of Óbuda University.

The supporting processes - financial, management, IT - and the infrastructure provide an excellent background for educational and research activities.

In its report, the Visiting Committee, in particular the 1.2. Areas to be developed, further developments are required by the DI. A priority area among these: the focus of the Degree Plan is diverse, going beyond the discipline of management and organizational sciences designated by the DI. The DI needs to focus on this currently quite diverse field of research. In order to ensure the value of the degree awarded, the DI supplements the publication requirements for obtaining a degree with a field-specific compliance requirement.
